

GREEK SANCTION SYSTEM

Rutgers-Camden University

I. Definitions

- a. "Greek affiliated Council" represents either the Inter-Fraternity Sorority Greek Council (IFSC) or the Rutgers Greek Council (RGC), whichever the particular Greek organization is affiliated with
- b. "Failure to attend a mandatory sanction" as used in II(b) or "Failure to attend a mandatory function" as used in III(b) also includes requirements that are established as a mandatory sanction/function pursuant to II(a) and III(a) that may not necessarily require attendance to a particular event

II. Sanctions

- a. A mandatory sanction is classified as the following:
 - i. Failure to attend meetings for the organization's affiliated Greek Council;
 - ii. Failure to attend committee meetings of such committees that are established by the Dean of Students, Assistant Dean of Students, the Greek Assistant, or the President of the affiliated Greek Council that require participation of all Greek organizations;
 - iii. Other events/requirements that are labeled as a sanction upon at least two (2) weeks notice from the Dean of Students, Assistant Dean of Students, the Greek Assistant, or the President of the affiliated Greek Council
- b. Failure to attend a mandatory sanction will result in the following:
 - i. Two Mandatory Sanctions Missed = Written notice by the President of the affiliated Greek Council
 - ii. Three Mandatory Sanctions Missed = One Mandatory Function (See III(b)(i))

III. Functions

- a. A mandatory function is classified as a monthly, semesterly, or annual meeting or session which participation in or attendance is mandatory. These include but are not limited to:
 - i. Presidents Roundtable Meetings;
 - ii. Annual Report;
 - iii. Community Service;
 - iv. Leadership Retreat;
 - v. Other events/requirements that are labeled as a function upon at least two (2) weeks notification of the Dean of Students, Assistant Dean of Students, the Greek Assistant, or the President of the affiliated Greek Council
- b. Failure to attend a mandatory function will result in the following sanctions:
 - i. One Mandatory Function Missed = A written notice from the Dean of Students, Assistant Dean of Students, the Greek Assistant, or the President of the affiliated Greek Council
 - ii. Two Mandatory Functions Missed = A warning letter from the Dean of Students, Assistant Dean of Students, the Greek Assistant, or the President of the affiliated Greek Council informing the organization

that upon missing their next mandatory function, they are placed on probation status and will be placed on inactive status if they obtain another function in the same academic year

- iii. Three Mandatory Functions Missed = An organization is automatically placed on inactive status.

IV. Timing

- a. All sanctions will last for one year beginning on the date of the sanction.
- b. All functions will last for one year beginning on the date of the function letter.

V. Inactive Status

- a. Inactive status may result from:
 - i. The accumulation of sanctions/functions; or
 - ii. By engaging in act(s)/incident(s)/behavior deemed by the Dean of Students or Assistant Dean of Students to warrant inactive status.
- b. An organization which has been placed on inactive status from their affiliated Greek Council is restricted from functioning as a group on campus, including the solicitation or induction of members, and loses all rights and privileges accorded to recognized student organizations.
- c. An organization which has been placed on inactive status is eligible to re-apply for recognition after the following:
 - i. One calendar year from the date of loss of recognition OR
 - ii. If applicable, when all conditions established by the Dean of Students or the Assistant Dean of Students has been satisfied

VI. Loss of Recognition

- a. An organization will lose recognition within the Rutgers-Camden Greek System if the organization:
 - i. Fails to comply with V(c)(i);
 - ii. Fails to satisfy the conditions established by V(c)(ii) if applicable; OR
 - iii. By engaging in act(s)/incident(s)/behavior deemed by the Dean of Students or Assistant Dean of Students to warrant loss of recognition
- b. An organization that loses recognition is required to reapply as a Greek organization, set forth by the Greek Recognition Policy.

VII. Recording Sanctions and Functions

- a. The secretary of the affiliated Greek Council, supervised by the President of that Council, is responsible for determining whether each organization within their Council has fulfilled its mandatory sanction and function level obligations.
- b. The secretary of the affiliated Greek Council, supervised by the President of that Council, is also responsible for maintaining a system that keeps track of all sanctions and functions once they have been obtained.
